

A BOARD + CARD GAME: ABC ANIMALS

This is a game for 2 - 4 players (or teams) to learn and practise English animal names.

Rules

1. Shuffle playing cards and put in a pile face down.
2. Take a turn by flipping a coin:
heads = move one space; tails = move two spaces.
3. When you land on a square with the flower, you take a card from the top of the pile, then name the animal.
For example: *This is a lion.*
4. If you are right, don't move.
If you are wrong, move back one space.

The winner is the first player to reach the finish.

You need



a game board



a set
of playing cards



a coin



a place marker
for each player

Preparation

Print out a game board and sets of playing cards. If you want, you can stick every printout onto the heavy paper. Cut out the individual cards, fold them and glue.

You can laminate your game board and cards for future use.

How to make your cards

1. Cut out.



2. Fold.



3. Glue.
